IF YOUR RETIREMENT DATE IS AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2004

You must notify Local 80 within 90 days of your retirement, choose an eligible Local 80 retirement plan through the Local's Accounting Office, and maintain the appropriate dues for that plan in order to be eligible to be reimbursed for prescription co-payments.

IF YOUR RETIREMENT DATE IS BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2004

Retirees who drop from the Local 80 retirement plan in which they were participating in 2004 will not be eligible to be reimbursed for prescription co-payments. Such retirees may convert from Plan #3 to Plan #1.

MILITARY WITHDRAWAL CARD AVAILABLE

Members in good standing (current on dues) who are called into active military service may request a Military Withdrawal Card. Requests must be accompanied by a copy of the member's order to report for active duty.

A member granted a Military Withdrawal may return to membership in Local 80 upon release from active duty by presenting a copy of their release order and paying dues for the then-current Quarter only.
